

Here is a list of discussion questions to ask your child or students to help them make personal connections to Howie Flies Solo.

- Howie is helpful to the animals he meets. Has anyone ever helped you do something? When have you ever helped someone out with a task?
- Have you ever seen an owl up close? Where were you and can you describe what it looked like?
- Do you know of any other animals that are nocturnal and hunt at night?
- Do you think an owl would make a good pet? Why or why not?
- What does this book remind you of? Have you read another book with any of the same animals in it?
- Why do you think it is important to help others?
- Howie gets distracted by all the night's sounds when he is flying. What types of things distract you from thinking at times?
- If you could be a nocturnal animal, what would you be and why?
- If you could fly like Howie where would you want to fly to?
- What else do you think owls eat? Research them on the computer.
